1. Welcome

2. Comments about 2012

Randy Fang gave short comments about the activity in 2012. Because of lack of time, he wants to retire as WOF president this year.

3. Review of initiatives from 2011 WOF meeting

At the 2011 meeting, it was decided to establish better criteria for becoming a WOF member. It was also decided that the WOC rule committee should give proposals for How to count women's score for team score, Handling of persons with disability and Penalty for not making transcript. None of these initiatives have been started yet, so the next WOF council will have to complete them.

Emmanuel Lazard will be responsible for the rule committee. The new WOF council will invite all WOF members to suggest other topics to be changed/added. An e-mail about this should be sent during November 2012.
